


# Turnitin

## Instructor Turnitin Assignment Set Up

In Course Navigation, click the **Assignments** link and then click the +Assignment button.

Once inside the assignment creation page you can add the following details:


- Title
- Instructions/Description
- Points Possible
- Grading Type,
- Submission Type- **Set to Online - File Uploads**
- Number of Attempts
- **Plagiarism Review** - Click the dropdown and choose Turnitin.
  - Choose your Turnit in settings. You can allow students to see the report. Save as default settings for future assignments.
- Group Assignment
- Peer Reviews
- Due Dates, and Availability Dates

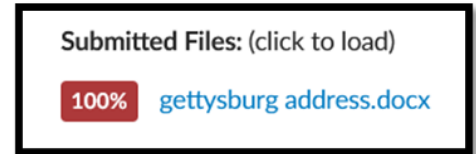
- Click to open the assignment

- Click Submit Assignment



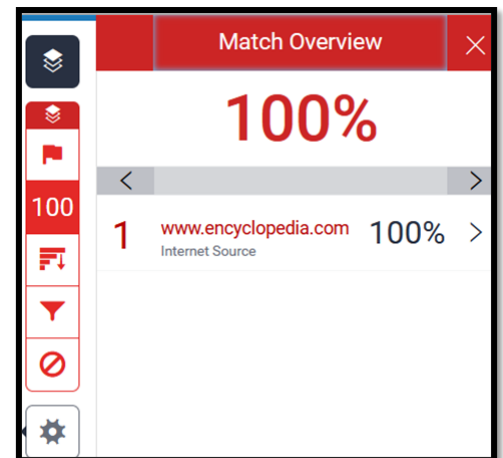

## Instructor- Similarity Report in SpeedGrader

- To view the similarity report Go into the assignment and click on SpeedGrader.
- On the right hand side next to the submitted file you will see a color coded score
  - Blue: No matching text.
  - Green: One word to 24% matching text.
  - Yellow: 25-49% matching text.
  - Orange: 50-74% matching text.
  - Red: 75-100% matching text.



- To view the report, click on the score and use the tools along the left to view the sources which are similar to the submitted assignment.



## Students - Viewing the Similarity Report

- The instructor must allow students to see the similarity report. This is done in the initial set up of the assignment under the Turnitin settings.
- To see the report students click on Grades from the course menu
- Navigate down to the specific assignment and click on the colored icon on the right



- Turnitin will have you agree to the End User License Agreement
- To view the report click on the score and use the tools along the left to view the sources which are similar to the submitted assignment. It looks the same as the instructor's view.
